Sierra Club comment submitted to Metro on the NoHo to Pasadena Transit Corridor Project

The Sierra Club has long envisioned a continuous east-west transit corridor along the 101-134-210 freeway corridor. This NoHo to Pasadena Transit Corridor Project will fill the gap between the Orange and Gold Lines and provide useful service to intermediate destinations including the Burbank Media District, downtown Burbank, Glendale, and Eagle Rock.

Therefore we support the Refined Street-Running Alternative on Colorado in Eagle Rock and a street alternative in downtown Glendale.

We also highlight the importance of developing attractive street sections with ample trees and other landscaping, especially where there are existing grass and trees in boulevard medians on Glenoaks and Colorado, that should be preserved as much as possible.
